This Foundation Degree is a distinctive higher education qualification which integrates work-based learning with the requirements of a national qualification. This is a work-based learning degree delivered by The University of Northampton in partnership with employers and the Institute of Leadership & Management (ILM).

The key characteristics of The University of Northampton Foundation Degree in Leadership and Management are:

- A high level of employer collaboration in tailoring course content to the needs of the business, with the opportunity for employers to shape some of the detail at the point of delivery and assessment.
- Work-based learning is central to the ethos of the programme design. Assessment is by work-based projects that are relevant to your business and are focused on ways of improving day-to-day performance.
- Minimum levels of absence from work. Typically we provide a one-day workshop every two months during the course of a two year programme. Each workshop can take place on the employer's premises or location of preference.
- High quality learning materials are specifically designed to integrate academic theory with real-life work.
- The ILM Level 5 Extended Diploma in Leadership and Management is incorporated within the programme.
- The opportunity to link to the organisations and individuals CPD activities.
- The qualification is accredited by The University of Northampton.
